

## 6<sup>th</sup> Batch Leadership Training



Scouts and Culture Education Division, Department of Youth and Sports, Ministry of Education in collaboration with the Office of the Gyalpoi Zimpon organized the 6<sup>th</sup> Batch Leadership Training for 125 Scouts (62 Boys and 63 Girls of class XII) from 19 Dzongkhags and 4 Thromdes. The Scouts participated in intensive Leadership Training for a duration of three weeks (3<sup>rd</sup> July- 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2016) at the Military Training Centre, Tencholing, Wangduephodrang. The selection of the Participants were firstly done at the School and then at the Dzongkhag/Thromde level based on the criteria set by the Department.

This prestigious training has shown positive impact on the youth changing them into better individuals pertaining to time management, improving communication, leadership and team building exercises, crowd management and strategizing, making decisions and solving problems. The training consisted of Physical exercises; Impromptu Speeches; White River Rafting; Rappelling; Camp Fire and Cultural Activities; Spiritual visit; Games Competition; and Sessions on Scouting, Life Skills, Disaster Risk Reduction and Preparedness, Forest Fire and its Consequences, Fire Fighting Techniques, First Aid and CPR, Patriotism, Loyalty

and “Thadamtse Lay Jumdey, Spirituality& Practical Application in daily life, Leadership Skills, Crowd Control & Road Safety,Peer Helping Skills, Reproductive Health, Jungle Survival Techniques, and Pioneering.

Further, among the 125 scouts who underwent this training, 5 Scouts will be provided scholarship for further studies based on their performance at the Scout Leadership Camp and their academic performance in the board examinations.
