1. General:

Thisagreementshallbeapartofthestandardbiddingdocument, which shall be signed by both the parties at the time of purchase of bidding documents and submitted along with the tender document. This IP is applicable only to "large" scaleworks, goods and services, the threshold of which will be announced by the government from time to time. The signing of the IP shall not apply to frame work contracting such as annual of fice supplies etc.

2. Objectives:

Whereas, the Employer and the Bidderagree to enter into this agreement, herein after referred to as IP, to avoid all forms of corruption or deceptive practice by following asystem that is fair, transparent and free from any influence/unprejudiced dealings in the bidding process of and contracted ministration of with a view to:

- Enabling the Employer to obtain the desired contract at a reasonable and competitive price inconformitytothedefinedspecificationsoftheworksorgoodsorservices; and
- 2.2. Enabling bidders to abstain from bribing or any corrupt practice in order to secure the contractbyprovidingassurancetothemthattheircompetitorswillalsorefrainfrombribing and other corruptpractices.

3. Scope:

The validity of this IP shall cover the bidding process and contract administration period.

4. Commitments of the Employer:

The Employer Commits itself to the following:-

- 4.1. The Employerhere by undertakes that no officials of the Employer, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the Bidder, either for themselves or for any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the bidding process and contract administration.
- 4.2. The Employer further confirms that its officials shall not favor any prospective bidder in any form that could afford an undue advantage to that particular bidder in the bidding process and contract administration and will treat all Bidders alike.

- 4.3. OfficialsoftheEmployer,whomayhaveobservedornoticedorhavereasonablesuspicion shallreporttotheheadoftheemployingagencyoranappropriategovernmentofficeany violationorattemptedviolationofclauses4.1and4.2.
- 4.4. Following report on violation of clauses 4.1 and 4.2 by official (s), through any source, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings shall be initiated by the Employer and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the bidding process and contract administration.

5. Commitments of Bidders

The Bidder commits himself/herself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of the bidding processand contractadministrationinordertosecurethecontractorinfurtherancetosecureitandin particular commits himself/herselftothefollowing:-

- 5.1. TheBiddershallnotoffer,directlyorthroughintermediaries,anybribe,gift,consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerageorinducementtoanyofficialoftheEmployer,connecteddirectlyorindirectly with the bidding process and contract administration, or to any person, organization orthirdpartyrelatedtothecontractinexchangeforanyadvantageinthebiddingprocessand contractadministration.
- 5.2. TheBiddershallnotcolludewithotherpartiesinterestedinthecontracttomanipulatein whatsoeverformormanner,thebiddingprocessandcontractadministration.
- 5.3. Ifthebidder(s)haveobservedornoticedorhavereasonablesuspicionthattheprovisionsof theIPhavebeenviolatedbytheprocuringagencyorotherbidders,thebiddershallreport suchviolationstotheheadoftheprocuringagency.

6. Sanctions for Violation:

Thebreachofanyoftheaforesaidprovisionsshallresultinadministrativechargesorpenal actions as per the relevant rules and laws.

- 6.1. ThebreachoftheIPorcommissionofanyoffence(forgery,providingfalseinformation, misrepresentation,providingfalse/fakedocuments,bidrigging,bidsteeringorcoercion) by the Bidder, or any one employed by him, or acting on his/her behalf (whether withor withouttheknowledgeoftheBidder),shallbedealtwithasperthetermsandconditionsof thecontractandotherprovisionsoftherelevantlaws,includingDe-barmentRules.
- 6.2. The breach of the IP or commission of any offence by the officials of the procuring agency shallbedealtwithaspertherulesandlawsofthelandinvogue.

7. Monitoring and Administration:
