Subject: 21st Education Policy Guidelines and Instructions

#### I. Introduction

As we begin the first year of the 9th Plan it is not only a time to reflect back on our achievements but also on what lies ahead. The government has as before placed the highest priority to the social sector, especially education. The Education sector has received 14.6% of the total 9th Plan outlay with Nu. 10209.41 million of which Nu. 7612.44 is the outlay for the Dzongkhags and Geogs. There are 134 Community schools to be established, 98 schools to be upgraded to Lower Secondary Schools, 31 schools to Middle Secondary Schools and 19 schools to Higher Secondary Schools. In addition, there is a need to build 15 new Lower Secondary Schools and 9 new Middle and Higher Secondary Schools. Besides this there are a lot of additional facilities that need to be built in the existing schools. Most of these activities as you know are to be executed at the Dzongkhag level. Therefore, the development of capacity at the Dzongkhag level is a huge challenge and of top priority.

Because of the success of the Education Sector in providing education there is a heightened pressure in ensuring that school graduates get employment. We are challenged by the huge task of ensuring that our youth are gainfully employed and are able to contribute productively to the development of the country. Towards this effort you are aware that a career education team went to all High Schools to educate our students on career options. We hope this has helped our students in realizing their own potentials and helped them to be guided in their career choices. This initiative will not stop here. As you know the Dasho Dzongdags have been requested to lead this career team in talking to our students every year.

In the decentralised process, monitoring and support mechanisms remain to be strengthened especially at the Geog level. The Department has placed qualified DEOs and ADEOs in almost all the Dzongkhags. At the local level too school clusters have been formed to address this issue. However, this further needs to be strengthened and developed to ensure that we have a sound and effective monitoring and support system in place.

Higher education is another area where the Department needs to work hard on. In the next five years we would like to see that a National University is established along with a Secretariat. Efforts towards this goal are already underway and government approval has already been accorded for the establishment of a Council for Higher Education.

In the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference we debated, discussed and recommended measures for making our schools more caring. In this respect we hope that all schools have taken steps towards ensuring the safety of our students and in making our schools more than just a place for academic study. We would like to see that equal if not more emphasis is being given in nurturing and guiding our future citizens.

#### II. Overview of the Status of Education

**Education Coverage** 

For the academic year 2002 the Department of Education established 12 Community Primary Schools in rural areas, upgraded 5 Primary Schools to Lower Secondary Schools, 8 Lower Secondary Schools to Middle Secondary Schools and 5 Middle Secondary Schools to Higher Secondary Schools. Two new private schools have also been established at the beginning of 2002.

#### Examinations

The complete localization of the class X examinations was done in 2001 with the first Bhutan Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (class X) conducted in December 2001. The Department has also been able to negotiate with the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi to have the ISC examinations (class XII) conducted in December. The first such pre-poned examination was held in December 2001. This procedure will facilitate students to process for admission to colleges and institutes at the beginning of the academic session in March as well as give adequate time for processing of admissions outside the country.

#### Lower Secondary School Certificate Examination Results 2001

In December 2001, of the 6670 students who appeared for the Lower Secondary School Certificate Examination, 5882 passed setting the pass percentage at 88.19%. In 2000 the pass percentage was 84.69%.

#### Bhutan Certificate of Secondary Education Examination Results 2001

In December 2001 the first Bhutan Certificate in School Examinations was held. A total number of 5037 regular, supplementary and private candidates registered for the examinations. Of these, 4510 candidates passed which gave an overall pass percentage of 86.50% as compared to 79.11% in Dec 2000.

#### ISC Results 2001

Of the total number of 1364 candidates who registered for the examinations, 1242 passed setting the pass percentage to 91.06% based on the number registered for the examinations. The pass percentage based on the regular candidates who appeared for the examination is 94.01% compared to 91.26% in March 2001. However, it is lower than the pass percentage of March 2001 examination results which was 91.4%.

### Examination Results of the Institute for Language and Cultural Studies (ILCS) 2001 In the Rigzhung X examinations 29 students have passed out of the 35 students who appeared for the examinations in Nov 2001. Two different examinations were conducted

at the class XII level because of the change in the syllabus. Of the 61 students who appeared for the examination in the new curriculum 56 of them passed. There were 6 students who appeared for the old syllabus examinations. All 6 were granted pass certificates.

Higher Education

One of the objectives of the Education Department for the 9<sup>th</sup> Plan is the establishment of a National University. Towards achieving this objective the formation of a Council for Higher Education as well as the modality of the University to be a federated system has already been approved by the government.

In order to increase the capacity at the degree level classes XI and XII have been phased out of Sherubtse College. The last batch of class XII students from Sherubtse sat for their examinations in December 2001.

#### Non Formal Education

The NFE programme has expanded to more than 265 Basic Literacy Centres with 9442 learners. The dropout rate from the courses has also been reduced from 60% in 1997 to 20% in 2001. There are 70 Post Literacy Centres with 1853 learners.

Special Education

The integration of disabled children into mainstream schools is being further strengthened. A small centre for Special Education particularly for those who have mobility problems is being established at Changangkha Junior High School.

A centre for the hearing impaired children is being established at Drugyel Junior High School to allow such children to attend the mainstream school at Drugyel Junior and Drugyel Higher Secondary Schools while being helped at the centre when necessary.

Similarly, the National Institute for the Disabled at Khaling is further being developed to particularly cater for the visually impaired children to help them access mainstream education at Khaling Junior and Jigme Sherubling Higher Secondary Schools.

A Braille Production Unit has been set up at CAPSD, NIE, Paro in March 2002. The unit wishes to meet the needs of visually impaired students for preparing learning materials in Braille, large print and audio-cassettes

#### **Teachers**

Status of Teacher Supply

One of the major problems faced by the Education Department is the shortage of teachers. In the 2001 teacher trainee selections, 425 teacher candidates have been selected and placed as apprentice teachers in various schools across the country. The apprentice teachers now teach in the schools for one whole academic year. It may also be mentioned that the remuneration for the apprentice teachers has been raised by the government from Nu. 2000 to Nu. 3000 per month. Around 437 teacher graduates from the two NIEs joined the schools and institutes around the country in 2001.

Another strategy as always in trying to improve the teacher shortage situation is the recruitment of expatriate teachers from India. In 2001 around 97 such teachers were recruited by the Department.

Based on this the overall teacher student ratio for 2002 is 1:34 against the 1:32 norm that we currently follow.

Pre-service Teacher Training
In an effort to alleviate the teacher shortage problem the intake capacity of the two NIEs has been increased by 86 more students at NIE - Samtse and 132 more students at NIE -Paro as compared to last year.

The Primary Teachers' Certificate (PTC) and the Zhungkha Teachers' Certificate (ZTC) programmes are being phased out of the NIE in Paro by the end of 2003. Another development in this area is that from henceforth the PGCE course will be treated as a pre-service course.

#### In-service Teacher Education

In addition to the up-gradation of teacher qualification through the NIEs distance education program and the up-gradation of academic qualification through the opportunities provided for teachers to appear for class X and XII examinations, we conducted many National Based In-service Programs during the winter vacations and sent a large number of teachers out of the country for attending special training courses.

In 2001 - 2002 approximately 815 teachers participated in 18 National Based In-service Programs.

A total of 79 teachers and teacher educators are currently undergoing various training courses abroad.

The Department has also resolved to train private school teachers in order to ensure that our private schools have well trained teachers conversant with our curriculum.

#### Sports and Games

Under the directives of the government the function of sports development and promotion has been transferred to the Youth Guidance and Counseling Division of the Department of Education.

#### III. Directives and Guidelines

#### 9th Plan Policy Objectives

As we launch the 9<sup>th</sup> Plan everyone should be aware of the main objectives of the 9<sup>th</sup> plan which are as follows:

- 1. Provide support mechanisms for early childhood care and development for children between 0 6 years of age on a pilot basis;
- 2. Enhance enrolment of children between 6-12 years of age in primary schools to 90-95% by 2007;
- 3. Enhance the quality of education to achieve competency in language, communication skills and mathematics comparable to international standards;
- 4. Improve and expand youth guidance and career counseling and value education towards a program for wholesome development of the youth;
- 5. Increase the basic education level from class VIII to class X;
- 6. Increase promotion proportion from class X to class XI from 38% to 56% by 2007;
- 7. \*Develop a higher education system under the umbrella of a National University with federated colleges that will meet the needs of the Bhutanese society and the economy;
- 8. Enhance literacy rate from 54% to 80% and establish a system of continuing and life long education opportunities complemented through the establishment of the National University;
- 9. Establish a programme of inclusive education (for children who are physically and mentally challenged) to enable them to partake in the general education that is provided to all children so that they could live with dignity and participate in the development of the Bhutanese society;
- 10. Strengthen and improve the education management system with particular emphasis on the school level management;
- 11. Develop a more sustainable education system through the introduction of private participation and cost sharing measures.

\*The National University will assume autonomous status once it is fully established and it will be delinked from the Department of Education.

#### 9th Plan Strategy

You are aware the 9<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan for the Education Sector as is the case with all other sectors has been initiated from the grassroots level, respective Dzongkhags propose all activities at the Dzongkhag level with participation from the Geog level. The total outlay for the Education Sector for this plan period is Nu. 10209.41 million.

This outlay is 3 times more than the 8th Plan outlay. It is an ambitious plan and as you would know most of the activities are to do with infrastructure building and most of it has to be carried out by the Dzongkhags. Therefore, it is of utmost importance that we have the right people with the right capacities in the Dzongkhags and the Geogs to successfully implement all our planned activities.

#### Fifth Annual Education Conference

The 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference was held in the National Institute of Education in Paro from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup> of December, 2001. A total of 122 participants comprising of selected heads of schools, heads of institutes, the Dzongkhag Education Officers, and officials from the headquarters participated in the 5 day conference. The first three days or the pre-conference was presided over by the Secretary of the Ministry of Health and Education. The last two days or the main conference was presided over by the Honourable Minister for Health and Education. The theme for the 5<sup>th</sup> Conference was 'Towards Caring Schools'. Many issues associated with making schools more caring were discussed and recommendations made.

A summary of the resolutions of the  $5^{th}$  Annual Education Conference is attached as *Annex I* for reference and necessary action.

We would like to know from the schools what activities you have initiated in making your schools more 'caring'.

The Teaching of English

Since the quality of education is a serious concern of the Department of Education, side by side with the expansion of education facilities, quality issues are also being addressed. Various reviews and studies are being undertaken by the Department of Education. Particularly the competency of English in our schools and college has been questioned at various levels.

The Centre for Educational Research and Development (CERD) at NIE Paro has led a study on the standard of English. The study reveals that there is much to be desired in the teaching of English, especially at the Secondary school level. A document that describes the standards to be achieved at various levels has been developed and circulated to the schools. We would like to urge our schools to use this document to enhance the teaching and learning of English. For queries and suggestions you may contact the CERD in NIE, Paro.

#### HRD Master Plan

In working towards a more comprehensive system of human resource development the Education Department has developed an HRD masterplan that will act as a guide for systematic training and upgrading of professional competencies of both educators and education administrators.

It includes a staffing pattern for all schools and institutes that has been drawn up with the objective of streamlining responsibilities, providing maximum learning opportunities and efficient use of staff. Copies have been sent to the DEOs, Heads of Institutes and Division Heads. This document is to be treated as a living document that will be reviewed when necessary. If there are any comments they may be sent to the Deputy Secretary, AFD, Ministry of Health and Education.

Regional Admission of Class XI Students in 2003

In order to ensure minimum trouble to students and parents in terms of traveling as well as to ensure proper and efficient use of the limited boarding places, class IX admissions have been decentralized to the Dzongkhags since 2001. It is the aim of the Department to do the same with the class XI admissions. However, at the moment because of the situation in some of the Dzongkhags class XI admissions are taking place in regional clusters.

Based on the feedback received from the regional clusters and the discussions held during the EFA workshop held on 18th July, 2002 criteria and guidelines have been drawn up for schools to adhere to. Please refer to *Annex II*.

The following schools are proposed to be upgraded to Higher Secondary Schools in order to accommodate the class XI students in 2003:

Cluster	School to be upgraded
1	Baylling MSS (new)
2	Mongar MSS to HSS
3	Sarpang MSS to HSS
4	Bajothang MSS to HSS
5	Phuentsholing MSS to HSS
6	Tsimalakha HSS to introduce science stream

The above schools in consultation with the Dzongkhags are asked to make appropriate arrangements to receive class XI students in March 2003. The grouping of the regional clusters would remain as last year.

Decentralised Monitoring and Support

In order to enhance and strengthen the management and support at the Dzongkhag level Assistant Dzongkhag Education Officers have been posted to almost all Dzongkhags.

Besides, to increase the effectiveness of our school system and the performance of our school staff in their effort towards providing quality education, the Department is in the process of expanding the monitoring and support services through a decentralised system. Towards this 21 more school clusters have been identified in addition to 10 such clusters that were established in 2001. It is the desire of the Department to make it a nation wide program phase wise. We would like the schools and the Dzongkhag Education Officers to reflect on how effective this system of monitoring and support is. This will be discussed at the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference.

At present, the Department is concentrating on strengthening the school level monitoring system. The EMSSD has conducted training workshops for DEOs and heads of schools in 12 Dzongkhags to familiarize them on the concept and use of the monitoring tools. The Department envisages institutionalizing this system in all our schools through similar workshops conducted in the rest of the Dzongkhags by the end of 2002.

It is also envisaged that most of the support for all schools could also be provided through the school clusters. There would be a resource centre for each of the school clusters and an adequate number of expertise placed in schools within each of the

clusters as Master Teachers who would extend their services to all schools within the cluster and beyond if their services are so demanded.

Computer Education / Information Technology

The Department of Education is exploring various ways of putting computers in schools. We hope to provide computers to every high school, if not all schools in a few years time. As part of this process of computerization, we have already supplied a few computers to some schools. Some schools have even procured computers through their own initiative, which is commendable.

Although the Department has supplied many computers to the schools we are now concerned about the effective utilization of these computers for educating our students. Towards this direction, we have started training computer teachers from all the high schools. You should draw on the expertise of your computer teachers to maximise the use of computers.

We are aware that some computers in schools are kept aside for administrative use, limiting students' access. While the computers may be used for enhancing school management, it is important that students become aware of the use of computers as an effective tool. To this end, the Department of Education would like your school to implement some of the suggestions put forward in *Annex III*.

#### Non Formal Education

The Department is now recruiting class X leavers as NFE instructors to work in their own communities. This strategy envisages that they will develop themselves into community leaders and they will be encouraged to take other part time jobs in the community. Those who are more able will be sent for community leadership courses outside the country.

The remuneration for the NFE instructors at Nu. 3000 per month for those under class X and Nu. 3500 for class X and above has also been approved by the government.

With effect from July 2002, the authority to approve the establishment of new NFE Centres and monitoring system has been decentralised and given to the Dzongkhags. Please refer to *Annex IV*.

#### Career Education

As part of the Department's effort towards strengthening the career education programme an intensive career education package tour was undertaken to all the High Schools in the country by a multisectoral team.

Henceforth the Dzongkhags under the leadership of Dasho Dzongdags are asked to continue this exercise in all high schools.

Teachers' Day

A resolution passed by the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference and approved by the government was the decision to observe Teachers' Day on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, coinciding with the birth anniversary of the Third King of Bhutan, Late His Majesty Jigme Dorji Wangchuck. This was launched with a special message to all our teachers by the Honourable Minister for Health and Education on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2002.

We would like the schools to continue to celebrate this day appropriately to honour our teachers on this day.

The Light of My Life

The book 'The Light of My Life' is an introduction to Buddhism. It contains the life story of Buddha and the basic principles of life that the Buddha taught to the people of his time. It was developed mainly to familiarize our children to the virtues of life that had been applied in the last 2,500 years and will be relevant for many centuries to come.

The book is not a text and so should not be used for examinations. It is to be read in value education classes, discussed, understood, and applied to life. Where possible, children should be encouraged to read the book on their own. In the lower classes teachers could read out from the book slowly and clearly to the children and show them the pictures. In both the cases reflection questions given in the book could be discussed with the children. At times children could be encouraged to narrate their own stories similar to the fables in the book. Some sentences and phrases from the book can also be written on chart papers and displayed in the classroom walls and corridors. It will also be nice if some students dramatized either the Buddha's life story or some of the fables.

We would be interested to know how this book is used. You can write to the Director, NIE, Paro for any queries or support.

Science Equipment and Library Books

The Department will supply science equipments and library books to schools when it is established or upgraded only. Thereafter the maintenance and supply of all consumable items will be met from the Dzongkhag budgets. The Dzongkhags have to budget these activities within the plans of the schools. All Dzongkhags should propose the requirement of any equipment or library books for any school that require these facilities within the Dzongkhag budget.

World Food Program

We have signed a new project with the WFP beginning July 2002 that will last till June 2007. We see that over the years the need for providing WFP assistance to schools has changed. Some schools that were earlier provided WFP assistance may now not require it while other schools that were not covered earlier may need this assistance.

Recently we have carried out a retargeting exercise that identified 6 schools to be phased out of the WFP program and 22 schools to be included in the program as shown in the table below:

We have already informed the respective dzongkhags to prepare for the withdrawal and introduction of WFP accordingly.

#### Curriculum Changes for 2003

CAPSD will be undertaking a review of the school curriculum for classes PP-XII with special emphasis on English and Mathematics in March and April 2003 along with two consultants. The review will focus mainly on major implementation successes and failures in schools. Further it will also analyse the curriculum as a whole.

For the 2003 academic session, some of the major changes in curriculum are explained in  $Annex\ V$  for information to all schools.

A revised booklist has been prepared for the academic session 2003. You should refer to the list for your 2004 requisition. If schools do not receive the items as per the list you must write to CAPSD or the Education Central Store or the Regional Education Stores. Please refer to *Annex VI*.

#### 6th Annual Education Conference

The 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference will be held from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 28<sup>th</sup> of December at the National Institute of Education in Paro.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference Recommendations (24<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2001) Theme: Towards Caring Schools

#### Recommendations of the main Conference:

Walking Distance to Schools

- 1. In view of the difficulties students face to walk long distances, particularly in rural areas:
  - schools are to be located within 3 kilometres or a maximum of 1 hour walking distance.
  - boarding provisions in nearby schools with stipends be made for those where it is not feasible to set up schools based on the above criteria.
- 2. In urban areas, the Department of Education should study the possibilities of zoning, use of existing transport facilities and utilisation of school buses to reduce the long distances that students walk.

Health, Nutrition and Stipend

- 3. To address the health needs of students, it is recommended that Health Department coordinate with schools and draw up a diet chart to provide a balanced diet preferably with locally available items and taking into account the tastes/preferences of children. Appropriate action should also be taken to ensure preparation of hygienic and nutritious food.
- 4. The Education Department shall review the costs involved in providing a balanced diet and propose an appropriate stipend rate.
- 5. Relevant WHO literature on mental health be adapted and distributed to schools to enable the teachers to become sensitive to the needs of the students and take appropriate measures.
- 6. A proper review of mental health problems in the schools was recommended to be done with the assistance of the Health Department.
- 7. Considering the increasing need of counselling in schools, more counsellors were recommended to be trained at the post graduate level.
- 8. Each school should develop a system of pastoral care targeted to be sensitive to individual student needs.

Code of Conduct for Teachers

- 9. The Code of Conduct for teachers was adopted with the recommendation that it be widely circulated to all teachers and that the NIEs incorporate it as an essential component of value education.
- 10. An agreement to abide by the Code of Conduct be signed by all teachers.
- 11. A task force to draw up appropriate actions for non-compliance be formed.

English and Study Skills

12. The study on English and study skills be continued and appropriate strategies worked out to improve the current low standards.

#### Ban on Tuition

- 13. The Education Department to reinforce the ban on tuition that was imposed in the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Education Conference including private school teachers who will be governed by the same rules as laid out under Section 10 of the MOU.
- 14. A system of peer help be instituted whereby brighter students help weaker ones in the spirit of volunteerism. An appropriate system of crediting such services be put in place.

Schools in Difficult Areas

15. To address the issues of schools in difficult areas, a committee was formed to study the problems and to come up with recommendations and report to the next conference.

Teachers Day

16. Given the importance of encouraging and recognising the contribution of teachers and to promote the teaching profession which is noble as it is, it is recommended that Teachers Day be observed on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, the birth anniversary of the third King, Late His Majesty, Jigme Dorji Wangchuck.

Special Education

- 17. The Conference recognised the need to pay more attention to special education needs. Based on the report of the survey on the disabled, the Conference recommended the action plan for the hearing impaired to be implemented. However the establishment of special schools in the 20 Dzongkhags will be reviewed further taking into consideration the capacity and resources.
- 18. The Education Department to work closely with Health Department on special education programmes.

National Cadet Service

19. The proposal of initiating a National Cadet Service at Sherubtse College was endorsed to be submitted to the government for consideration in light of interest shown by students and the benefits such a service could provide to self as well as national development.

Secondment of Teachers to the Private Schools

20. The conference recommended that 10% of teachers in private schools may be seconded from the government and that Personnel Division explore the possibility of superannuated teachers joining the private schools to address the problem of education in private schools.

3 years Compulsory Posting in Remote Schools for Teachers

21. While the Conference recommended a 3 year remote school posting for all teachers, a committee was to be formed to propose appropriate implementation strategies.

9th Five Year Plan

- 22. The objectives, strategies and programmes of the 9<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan were endorsed by the Conference.
- 23. The initiatives in the implementation modalities and monitoring of school constructions in the 9<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan were endorsed and the proposal to pilot new initiatives in construction was approved in view of the large number of facilities proposed to give access to quality education.

#### Guidelines for Regional Admission of Class XI Students

#### 1. Best All Rounder Student

To facilitate merit scholarships for best all rounder students in Class XI, all Middle Secondary Schools & Higher Secondary Schools are to submit the names and details of the Best All Rounder Student to SLC by Dec 2002, submissions made after December will not be considered.

#### 2. Budget

The Regional Clusters Chairpersons are required to propose budget for cluster meetings/placements etc in their Dzongkhag Annual Budgets.

#### 3. Regional Meetings

All DEOs, Principals of HSS and MSS with Class X Candidates are required to attend the regional meetings. This has been made compulsory.

#### 4. Security Clearance Certificate

- All Middle Secondary Schools & Higher Secondary Schools that have Class X and XII are required to process for the security clearance certificate for their students from the RBP Headquarter in Thimphu.
- No Security Clearance Certificate for admission to all levels of academic studies within the country is required.
- Security Clearance Certificate for Sherubtse Graduates to be processed under Adult & Higher Education Division.

#### 5. Class XI Results

BBE to declare BCSE (Class X) results within the second week of February every year.

#### 6. Class XI Admissions

Class XI admissions to be conducted in the 1st week of March every year.

#### 7. Selection/Placement Interview

Every eligible candidate to attend selection/placement interviews in the respective regional cluster centres on day of selection/placement as announced year to year.

#### 8. Choice of Stream and School

- Choice of school within Regional Cluster and stream will be awarded on merit basis based on the aggregate of English + 4 best subjects for Arts.
- Commerce will be based on the aggregate of English + 4 best subjects with a minimum of 40% in Math.
- Science will be based on a minimum of 45% in Math and an aggregate of 60% in the sum of math and science. For merit order listing in case of excess candidates the sum of math and science will be considered.
- Students within walking distance to any Higher Secondary School to be retained/placed as day scholars.

9. Citizenship ID Card

Citizenship ID Card should be produced on the day of Selection / Placement Interview. No admission will take place without production of Citizenship ID Card. Schools are required to notify all students.

#### 10. Seats

All DEOs with Higher Secondary Schools are required to submit the details of seats available for admission of class XI in 2003 latest by August 2002.

#### 11. Class IX Placements

All Dzongkhags are required to make arrangements for admission of their class VIII passed candidates in their own Dzongkhags and for those Dzongkhags where there are no adequate facilities they should negotiate and make placements in other Dzongkhags within their Regional clusters.

#### Suggestions for the Use and Care of Computers

- (1) Place all computers (even if there is only one) and accessories in a centrally located place in school. Where there are one or two computers, it will not be possible for students to use the computers but they can, at least see teachers use the computers. This would help develop some appreciation of the power of technology in our children, and thus they would not feel inadequate and apprehensive to use this tool in their world of work later.
- (2) Schools with more than three or four computers should conduct IT literacy activities. This may be done in-groups to involve more students. However, it may be more feasible and beneficial to target students in terminal classes i.e. Class 8, 10 or 12 in secondary schools.
- (3) Form small interest groups-clubs, forums, etc-geared towards use of computers. Members of such groups could be given hands-on experience in using basic computer applications. To increase accessibility to computers, members of these groups could be periodically changed.
- (4) Members of various committees, students included, in schools could use computers to generate their work and display them. This could involve preparation of games and sports schedules, literary wall magazines, news bulletins, pamphlets on health hazards and environments, etc.
- (5) Where possible, arrange scheduled access to computers for students after class hours. More students could have access to computers thus.
- (6) Your IT teacher should be entrusted with the full responsibility of managing computer classes and maintaining the equipment. This would enable him/her to plan various IT activities and take proper care of the equipment.
- (7) All equipment must be well protected from dusts. Dust induces heat and can severely reduce the performance and lifespan of computers. Schools should use dust covers for their equipment. All students using computers must be made aware of this basic rule of maintenance.
- (8) Where the school has availed themselves of Internet connection, it should be made accessible to both teachers and students alike. Both teachers and students could benefit much from its use. Work out convenient but separate timing for teachers and students.

Irrespective of the number of computers you have in your school, please ensure that *all computers are accessible to your students*, even if the accessibility is limited to just knowing about computers or seeing how someone uses them.

#### Revised Procedure for the Establishment of New NFE Centres and Monitoring System

This is to notify all Dzongkhags about the change of procedure for establishment of new NFE Centres and monitoring system. As decided in the meeting with Dasho Dzongdags on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2002, full authority to approve the establishment of new NFE centres is given to Dzongkhags. However, the Dzongkhags are requested to follow the following guidelines for establishment of new NFE centres as informed in our earlier circular:

1. Modality for Establishment of New NFE Centres

Unlike in the past, no NFE centres will be established in an adhoc manner from now onwards. Starting 2003 all new centres across the country will be established together at the same time as mentioned below:

- Before December, Geogs will compile and finalise the list of new NFE centres to be established in the next academic year in different Chuwogs and communities.
- Before end of December, Geogs will submit the finalized list of new centres for accord of approval from Dzongkhags.
- By end of January, Dzongkahgs will finalise the list, approve and convey the approval to the Geogs.
- By first week of March, Dzongkhags should submit a list of new NFE centres approved for establishment along with the requisition for recruitment of new NFE instructors
- Between *February* and *April*, *Geogs* will arrange and keep all the learning materials and stationery ready in different centres.
- *NFED* will select, recruit, provide induction course and deploy instructors in *April* where required.
- By 1<sup>st</sup> May, literacy classes will commence.

2. Reporting and Monitoring System

Starting 2003 the submission of existing QPR system will be abolished. Instead the following reporting and monitoring system will be instituted:

- *Dzongkhags* should ensure that every individual NFE centre has local NFE committee (*Tshogpa*) formed before approving the establishment of centre.
- Dzongkhags should direct the Tshogpas to convene meetings at least three times a year to
  review and support the programme. (Once in the beginning for preparation of annual
  plan, second meeting sometime in the middle of the course to review the progress and
  once at the end of the course to evaluate the achievements and plan for the next batch).

- Dzongkhags and Geogs should formally identify a parental school for the NFE centres and entrust the responsibility for monitoring and professional support.
- By first week of May, Centres should submit a report in the prescribed form verified by the respective parental school to the gups. Gups should compile report in the prescribed form and submit to reach DEOs office by third week of May. By the end of June, DEOs should submit the compiled report to NFED in the prescribed form. The report, as required in the prescribed form will reflect the details on completion rate, new enrolment in both old and new centres.
- Dzongkhags should develop monitoring mechanism involving the gups, tshogpas and parental school to ensure quality and smooth functioning of the programme.
- NFED will provide only technical support in developing monitoring system at local level. Unlike in the past, NFED may not be able to visit each and every centre in the Kingdom. However, NFED will visit only selected centres to monitor the progress and effectiveness of the programme in the geogs and dzongkhags in general.

Henceforth, all Dzongkhags and Geogs will observe the new modality/procedures to plan, establish new NFE centres and monitor the programme.

Block period for science classes for VII – VIII and in primary classes:

It is strongly believed that science without practising scientific methods is not a science. The science curriculum for classes IV to VIII is activity oriented to accommodate learning and practise of scientific methods in science classes. Accordingly, schools were urged through the CAPSD Newsletter and earlier QPGI to allocate at least two block periods as we launched the implementation of science for classes VII and VIII in 1999 and 2000.

Some of the main objectives of enforcing such approach were to facilitate:

- students to practice scientific methods of observing, measuring, recording, solving
  problems through investigations, communicating their finding and develop positive
  attitudes towards science;
- science classes to be action packed;

- students enjoy science learning;
- students to have opportunities to relate and apply the learnt concepts in their day to day life;
- to discourage rot learning;
- promote the skill of learning science in students on their own.

However, as we hear from many science teachers' uniformity in the allocation of block periods across the country has not been followed. As a consequence, it is understood that students hardly get opportunities to practice scientific methods in the process of science teaching and learning.

Inspite of the inconveniences schools have in time tabling, it is further reiterated that science classes inclusive of primary classes be allocated three block periods a week in each academic session.


