## Announcement for the post of Education Attache (Dzongkha) at RBE, New Delhi

In accordance with the decision of the 338<sup>th</sup> HRC meeting held on 25.02.2022, the Ministry of Education is pleased to announce the vacancy for the post of *Education Attache (Dzongkha)* at Royal Bhutan Embassy, New Delhi for a period of 3 years (*non-extendable*) from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

Interested in-service candidates appointed on regular services and fulfilling the eligibility criteria given below may apply to HRD, MoE on or before **20th March 2022** (Click here to apply):

- 1. Possess B.Ed./PGCE/PGDE in Dzongkha;
- 2. Good command over written and spoken English (Test will be conducted);
- 3. Currently teaching in government schools;
- 4. Seniority in the service (P3A and above);
- 5. "Good" and above in the Moderation Exercise for 2019 and 2020
- 6. Not undertaken Study Leave/EOL and Secondment in the last 2 years (Fulfilled 2 years on the application deadline, if undertaken);
- 7. Those served as Dzongkha teacher outside Bhutan previously under similar arrangement shall be disqualified;
- 8. Have at least 5 years to serve before superannuation; and
- 9. Clean service record;

## Documents required to submit while applying online within the deadline:

- 1. Duly filled Application Form;
- 2. Updated CV generated from Zest (as of December 2021);
- 3. Academic Transcript and Certificate of Bachelor's degree or Masters;
- 4. Valid Audit clearance certificate for interview (To be verified online by HRD)
- 5. Valid Medical Fitness Certificate;
- 6. Valid Security Clearance Certificate (To be verified online by HRD)
- 7. Moderated results for 2019 and 2020 authenticated by concerned HRO with signature and seal;
- 8. Copy of relevant training certificate (s), if any; and
- 9. Statement from the immediate Supervisor highlighting his/her performance, achievement, behavior, language proficiency, attitude etc);

Candidates are requested to apply online through the google form which will be closed after 20<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at 5:00PM.

In the event, there are multiple applicants for the single slot, the candidates will be shortlisted based on the following criteria.

- 1. Seniority in service;
- 2. Rural posting; and





3. Moderation results for the year 2019 & 2020 (last two year).
