2. Background and Proposed Field of Study (FORM B)
3. Recommendation Form (FORM C)
4. Two copies of Degree Certificate
5. Two copies of Academic Transcript
6. Two copies of Passport
7. Two recent photo (4.5cm x 3.5cm)
8. Two copies of certificate of English Proficiency test (TOEFL or IELTS)*
9. Two copies of Curriculum Vitae
10. LTT Review Checklist (Form 9/D) (For Dzongkhag HRO)
11. Nomination Form

**While certificates of TOEFL and IELTS are desired, interest candidates may submit English Language Proficiency Certificate in the event the candidates are not able to furnish the aforementioned certificates.*

Important Note:

- The three scholarships are not exclusively for Bhutan and the project is anticipating receiving the proposals for the three scholarships for specified Master programme from Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Vietnam, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Indonesia, Philippines, Timor-Leste and Mongolia.
- The selection interview is expected to be scheduled on 15th June 2022 virtually.
- The Ministry will screen the documents for vetting the eligibility of candidates which will be submitted to the Royal Civil Service Commission.
- All the proposals must be submitted to the Ministry of Education latest by **5th May 2022** after receiving the recommendation and endorsement from the Dzongkhag HRC.
- Upon successful completion of the above course, the candidates are expected to serve in the same school for at least 5 years.
- The Ministry will send the list of eligible candidates from the above 11 schools implementing the Princess Project to RCSC and the donor agency will carry out the final selection.
