The Ministry of Education and Skills Development is pleased to announce the TOP TEN positions of the National-level CodeMonkey game development competition held on 16 February 2023. The competition was aimed at students in classes VII and VIII across the country, who engaged in a three-hour game development challenge using the CodeMonkey platform.

A total of 157 students participated in the competition, and each student was provided with a CodeMonkey account that included five game-building courses for practice. Additionally, each student was assigned a focal teacher who provided guidance and support to prepare for the competition.
