## Announcement for Recruitment and Placement of Regular Contract Teachers (RCT), 2023

The Ministry of Education and Skills Development would like to announce the following for the short-listed candidates for the recruitment of Regular Contract Teachers:

## **Important Notes:**

- 1. As per our announcement and eligibility criteria, 69 candidates are eligible for the post for Regular Contract Teacher (RCT) who scored 50% and above but was not selected as regular teacher.
- 2. The documents were verified based on the result of Bhutan Civil Service Examination (BCSE in teaching category only).
- 3. Besides furnishing the Security Clearance Certificate, the applicants will be informed in writing about the disqualification should there be any adverse records of any type and degree maintained with the Royal Bhutan Police or found adverse record maintained with the Anti-corruption Commission.
- 4. The candidates marked as shortlisted in ZRS should report to the HRD on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 (9.00 AM) with the following documents:
  - I. Duly filled 2 copies of contract agreement (Form 5/2)
  - II. 2 copies of Oath of Allegiance (Form 4/3)
  - III. All the original documents submitted through online along with a copy.
  - IV. 6 legal stamps
  - V. 4 passport size recent photos
  - VI. Nu. 245 (in cash)
  - VII. Education Bio-Data Form
- 5. The candidates must furnish the No Objection Letter from the current employer, if employed during the time of the placement. If the candidates fail to submit it and are found out to be employed at any point of time, their appointment as Regular Contract Teacher shall be revoked with immediate effect.
- 6. The candidates must undergo and pass the "DRUG TEST" as required by the BCSR 2018.
