All Class XII passed Arts students of 2022 BHSEC eligible to apply for a Bachelor of Education (BEd Sec.) in IT at Samtse College of Education are requested to kindly note and comply with the following information:

1. The registration for admission will open on 26th May 2023 at 9:00 AM and close at Midnight on 1st June 2023.
2. Students applying for the programme must ensure to provide the required information correctly using the link given on the College website at [www.sce.edu.bt](http://www.sce.edu.bt). If any of the information is missing or there is a mismatch in the information provided, the applicant will be automatically disqualified from applying.
3. A total of 200 applicants will be shortlisted for the final selection interview and the list will be uploaded on the college website on 7th June 2023.
4. The face-to-face selection interview shall be conducted at the Office of the Vice Chancellor, Royal University of Bhutan in Thimphu from 13th to 17th June 2023.
5. Only 140 applicants will be selected, and the list of selected applicants will be uploaded on the college website on 26th June 2023

Admission Criteria for BEd Secondary in IT at Samtse College of Education

Bachelor of Education (Secondary) IT	140  (All under Higher Education Grant)	<p><b><u>For eligibility</u></b></p> <p>Class XII pass (BHSEC or equivalent) with the following specific conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A minimum of 50% each in English and Dzongkha in Class X.</li> <li>• A minimum of an aggregate of 55% for English plus the best 4 subjects in Class X.</li> <li>• A minimum of 60% score each in English and 50% in Dzongkha in Class XII.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>For shortlisting</u></b></p> <p>Eligible applicants will be merit ranked based on their academic achievements in Classes X and XII in the ratio of 30% to 70% respectively. For Class X, the marks will be based on English plus four best subjects. For Class XII, it will be based on ability rating points as follows:</p> <p><b>Arts stream</b></p> <table style="margin-left: 40px;"> <tr><td>English</td><td>x 5</td></tr> <tr><td>ICT</td><td>x 5</td></tr> <tr><td>Mathematics</td><td>x 4</td></tr> <tr><td>Dzongkha</td><td>x 2</td></tr> <tr><td>Any other subject</td><td>x 1</td></tr> </table> <p>Of these, the top 200 applicants will be shortlisted for face-to-face selection interviews. The interview will test their academic proficiency (including English language and subjects' contents), communication skills, clarity of speech, creativity, analytical skills, personal attributes, aptitude and attitude to become a teacher.</p> <p><b><u>For selection</u></b></p> <p>The final selection of 140 candidates will be based on the following selection criteria.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Academic performance in Class X: 15%</li> <li>• Academic performance in Class XII: 25%</li> <li>• Performance in the interview: 60%</li> </ul>	English	x 5	ICT	x 5	Mathematics	x 4	Dzongkha	x 2	Any other subject	x 1
