Executive Summary

This Annual School Performance Report provides information about the holistic Performance of schools for the year 2019. The holistic performance assessment considered the three scorecards viz. the academic achievement, the enabling practices and the physical and psycho-social ambiences of schools.

The report presents the lists of schools which appeared in top-10 in four different levels; classes III, VI, X and XII for the academic years 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019. The report also highlights the comparative Academic Learning Scores (ALS) of the nation for the last four years in terms of percentage of students who scored an aggregate of more than or equal to 45%, 60% and 70% categories in their final assessment scores.

The targets set for each category as per **SPMS** are 100%, 80% and 40% for 45%, 60% and 70% categories respectively. This means that 100% of students should score more than or equal to 45%, 80% of students should score more than or equal to 60% and 40% of students should score 70% and above in their final assessment scores. The ALS report shows that class III students have achieved the targets under 60% and 70% categories, while class VI students have achieved the target under the category of 70%. However, classes X and XII have not achieved the target for all the three categories.

The main part of the report provides comparative ALS of each Dzongkhag and Thromde for the past four years. This report gives **avenue** for the 20 Dzongkhags and 4 Thromdes to conduct diagnostic study on the academic performance of students in their Dzongkhags/ Thromdes and initiate appropriate interventions to improve the performance.

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Introduction

The information and data presented in the report are drawn from the School Performance Management System (SPMS) 2019. SPMS is a system instituted in 2010 to provide schools and Dzongkhags with the tools to manage their own performance. In addition, this system informs stakeholders on the overall performance of schools based on three key scorecards, namely, Academic Learning Score (ALS), Enabling Practices Score (EPS), and Gross National Happiness (GNH). These three scorecards cover all the aspects of school practices.

The performances of schools are assessed holistically based on the three elements of School Performance Management System (SPMS). They are School Self-Assessment (SSA), School Improvement Plan (SIP) and School Performance Scorecards. School Performance scorecards consist of Academic Learning Scorecards (ALS), Enabling Practices Scorecard (EPS) and Gross National Happiness Scorecard (GNH), which includes physical and psycho-social components.

SSA is a tool, used by schools to reflect and assess their performance in a systematic and comprehensive manner. It takes into account the functioning of school leadership and management, students' learning outcome, students and teachers' engagement and their wellbeing. This is done at the start of the year and reviewed in the middle of the academic year.

SIP is a tool used by schools to prepare an improvement plan by setting targets for the academic year and developing action **plan** to achieve the desired improvements based on SSA. This is developed at the beginning of the year and reviewed towards the end of the year. SIP is endorsed by Dzongkhag Education Officers (DEOs) and Thromde Education Officers (TEOs) during the first round school visits. DEOs/TEOs validate the achievement and ratings of schools using EPS & GNH Scorecards during the second-round visit. The final agreed ratings are submitted through online to EMD.

While EPS and GNH aspects are rated through physical observations by DEOs/TEOs during the year, ALS is reported at the end of the year. ALS is the outcome of the yearend academic performance of students, which is based on BCSEA examination results of Classes X and XII, and school's assessments for classes III and VI.

The details of the report are as under:

- Overall performance of Dzongkhag/Thromde based on three Scorecards;
- Top 10 schools for the year 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 at classes III, VI, X and XII levels;
- National level comparative analysis of ALS in different categories at four levels for 2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019; and
- Comparative analysis of ALS of Dzongkhags/Thromdes for the past four years.

The result of School Performance for 2019 was declared on 3rd April 2020 after endorsement of top ten schools by HRC on 17th March 2020. The top 10 schools in four class levels (III, VI, X & XII) were recognised with certificates and cash prizes. Cash prizes and certificates were also awarded to the schools that made significant improvement in their overall weighted scores.

ALS Analysis of the Nation for the past 4 years

The Ministry of Education introduced the School Performance Management System in 2010 with the following Academic Learning Scores (ALS) targets:

- 100% of the students in classes III, VI, X and XII should score more than or equal to 45% in their final assessment;
- 80% of the students in those classes should score more than or equal to 60%;
- 40% of the students should score more than or equal to 70%.




Figure 1: ALS-Class III

The overall academic performance of class III in 2019 has improved from that of previous years. There is significant improvement in 2019 with 90.6% of students scoring in 60% and above category. Students have also achieved the targets of 60% and 70% categories.




Figure 2: ALS-Class VI

Over the four years period, the academic performance of class VI has improved in all the three categories. Students have achieved the targets of 70% category. The figure also shows that there is significant improvement in 60% and above category in 2019 compared to 2016.






Figure 4: ALS-Class XII

The performance is progressive in 70% and above category. However, only 16.74% of students could achieve against the set target of 40% in 2019. Students performed inconsistently in 45% and 60% categories.

ALS analysis of Dzongkhag/Thromde, 2019

Bumthang Dzongkhag

Ministry of Education (MoE) measures the academic learning score of schools using School Performance Management System (SPMS) as the tool. As per SPMS, the performance is measured based on three categories of students:

Category 1: Percentage of students scoring an aggregate of more than or equal to 45%,

Category 2: Percentage of students scoring more than or equal to 60%, and

Category 3: Percentage of students scoring more than or equal to 70% in their annual consolidated result.

The performance of students is considered to be good or otherwise based on the percentage of students scoring 60% and above since 60% is considered the 1st Division marks. The cut off marks for higher studies is also around 60% while the percentage required for selection to job market also is on average 60%.





Figure 5: ALS-Class III

In the past four years, a total of 1,203 students appeared class III annual examinations.

As per figure 5, the percentages of students scoring 45%, 60% and 70% and above had increased since 2016 till 2018. The percentages dropped in all three categories in 2019. The best performance in the past four years was in 2018 with 96.59% of students scoring 60% and above. The Dzongkhag achieved the targets of second and third categories.

In the last four years, a total of 1,175 students appeared class VI examinations.

As per the figure above, the academic learning score of class VI students had improved consistently from 2016 onwards. However, there is a slight drop in percentage of students scoring 60% and above in 2019. Students had performed the best in 2018 with 78.45% of them scoring 60% and above. The Dzongkhag achieved the targets of first and third categories.




Figure 7: ALS-Class X

In class X, a total of 1,151 students appeared BCSE in the last four years.

Comparatively, students had performed the best in 2018 with 74.58% of students scoring greater than or equal to 60%. The worst performance in the last four years was in 2017 with only 54.98% scored 60% and above. There is a significant improvement in percentage of students scoring 60% and above in 2019 from that of 2017.




Figure 8: ALS-Class XII




Figure 9: ALS-Class III





Figure 10: ALS-Class VI




Figure 12: ALS-Class XII




Figure 13: ALS-Class III




Figure 14: ALS-Class VI





Figure 15: ALS-Class X




Table 29: ALS Analysis of Class III (2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019)




Figure 17: ALS-Class III




Figure 18: ALS-Class VI




Figure 19: ALS-Class X




Figure 20: ALS-Class XII




Figure 21: ALS-Class III





Figure 22: ALS-Class VI




Figure 24: ALS-Class XII




Figure 25: ALS-Class III




Figure 26: ALS-Class VI




Figure 27: ALS-Class X




Figure 28: ALS-Class XII




Figure 29: ALS-Class III




Figure 30: ALS-Class VI




Figure 31: ALS-Class X




Figure 32: ALS-Class XII




Figure 33: ALS-Class III




Figure 34: ALS-Class VI




Figure 35: ALS-Class X




Figure 36: ALS-Class XII






Figure 38: ALS-Class VI




Figure 39: ALS-Class X




Figure 40: ALS-Class XII




Figure 41: ALS-Class III





Figure 42: ALS-Class VI




Figure 44: ALS-Class XII




Figure 45: ALS-Class III




Figure 46: ALS-Class VI




Figure 47: ALS-Class X




Figure 48: ALS-Class XII




Table 61: ALS Analysis of Class III (2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019)




Figure 49: ALS-Class III

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


Figure 50: ALS-Class VI




Figure 51: ALS-Class X




Figure 52: ALS-Class XII






Figure 54: ALS-Class VI




Figure 55: ALS-Class X




Figure 56: ALS-Class XII




Figure 57: ALS-Class III




Figure 58: ALS-Class VI




Figure 59: ALS-Class X




Figure 60: ALS-Class XII






Figure 1: ALS-Class III




Figure 2: ALS-Class VI





Figure 3: ALS-Class X




Figure 61: ALS-Class III




Figure 62: ALS-Class VI




Figure 63: ALS-Class X




Figure 64: ALS-Class XII




Figure 65: ALS-Class III




Figure 66: ALS-Class VI




Figure 67: ALS-Class X




Figure 68: ALS-Class XII




Table 85: ALS Analysis of Class III (2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019)




Figure 69: ALS-Class III




Figure 69: ALS-Class VI




Figure 70: ALS-Class X




Figure 71: ALS-Class XII




Figure 72: ALS-Class III




Figure 73: ALS-Class VI




Figure 74: ALS-Class X




Table 93: ALS Analysis of Class III (2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019)




Figure 76: ALS-Class III




Figure 77: ALS-Class VI




Figure 78: ALS-Class X




Figure 79: ALS-Class XII




Table 97: ALS Analysis of Class III (2016, 2017, 2018 & 2019)




Figure 80: ALS-Class III




Figure 81: ALS-Class VI




Figure 82: ALS-Class X




Figure 83: ALS-Class XII







Figure 84: ALS-Class III




Figure 86: ALS-Class X




Figure 87: ALS-Class XII




Figure 88: ALS-Class III




Figure 89: ALS-Class VI




Figure 90: ALS-Class X




Figure 91: ALS-Class XII




Figure 92: ALS-Class III




Figure 93: ALS-Class VI





Figure 94: ALS-Class X
